



RSU INFORMATION FOR IBM® Z/VM® VERSION 6 RELEASE 4.0 INSTALL PACKAGE

Only the RSU received with your z/VM product order (on DVD or delivered electronically) may be used in conjunction with your installation of z/VM. The physical DVD will be marked "For use with z/VM Installation only" or for electronic delivery, the file will have a minimum of 61 files. The RSU will be automatically installed during the z/VM installation process.

RSU CONTENTS

Along with the z/VM installation package, and the set of products shipped with z/VM V6.4, there is an RSU provided. This RSU contains the IBM® recommended service that will be installed when you install z/VM.

RSU PACKAGE LEVEL IDENTIFIER

In addition to the individual product RSU service levels, the z/VM RSU also has a package level identifier. The format of the RSU package level identifier is:

VRNNRSU - where V is the Version number, R is the release number and NN is the sequential number of the RSU for that version and release.
Example: 6401RSU, 6402RSU, etc.

The package level will be reflected on the external physical DVD label or as part of the file name of an electronically delivered file. The service level of each individual product is reflected separately. The service level of all products and features serviced by RSU will continue to be in the format of YYNN level.

Once you have installed z/VM and the installation RSU, you may use one of the following commands to see information about the service levels that were installed by the installation RSU.

- The command "VMFUPDAT SYSSUF" will display a table of all the components on your system and their current service and production levels.
- The command "SERVICE ALL STATUS" will display the current service and production RSU levels on your console.
