The latest release of z/VM went out the door in December and it contains a number of significant changes for performance. This presentation will cover those changes and provide some measurement results. These changes include large real memory exploitation, new hardware assists, and improvements in I/O performance. The most significant of these is the large real memory exploitation. This presentation will also provide some background as to how this exploitation was implemented.

In addition, Aduva is designed to leverage its dependency KnowledgeBase to improve system security, availability and compliance.
